Position Summary: Onsite General Construction Tradesman responsible for performing all general Construction duties from start to finish, implementing high standards of quality, reviewing of plans, understanding of project specifications, scopes of work, architectural and structural details etc. provided by the Foreman or Project Superintendent.

Responsibilities

1. Be well versed in all General Construction trades, Incl. Understanding of foundations and their components, layout and Installation of structural and interior wall assemblies, incl. sheer walls, light gauge metal framing, floors, ceilings, roof layout and framing, sub straights, installation of sheet metal flashings, familiar with using materials such as: wood, steel, concrete, plastics, gypsum board and composites of multiple materials. Fit and install window frames and window flashings, doors, door frames, door hardware, interior and exterior siding and trim, Stair lay-out and fabrication a plus
2. Ability to read blueprints and schematics
3. Must be able to supply all necessary hand and power tools and operate company supplied equipment necessary to perform construction tasks. Knowledge of all material as required per project specifications and drawings.
4. Understand in detail all required information such as procedures, plans, scopes of work and job specifics to ensure that schedule and goals are met in the most efficient manner that enables high quality of craftsmanship requirements are met.
5. Ensure the accuracy of work by checking completed projects with tools such as levels, surveying equipment, or framing squares; corrects problems as needed.
6. Examine building materials to identify any defects.
7. Must have skills to resolve and deter any problems or conflicts that may arise and must be willing and able to adapt to changes within the work environment.
8. Provide the support and the tools to work with fellow Strategic Industry employees and subcontractors. Follow company policies and procedures.
9. Follow the requirements of Cal OSHA, SWPPP, City Ordinances, Job Site Safety and Environmental Protection Plans.
