Position Summary: Journeyman Electricians will work in commercial, industrial, education, and government environments. Follow proper safety protocol, quality control and industry standard installation methods and comply with applicable electrical code to ensure a successful project.

Essential Functions:

1. Installing conduit systems such as: EMT, O-CAL, Rigid conduit, strut, cable trays
2. Troubleshooting electrical components, wiring diagrams, transformers, motors, panels, and circuits
3. Installing, maintaining, and repairing electrical systems such as: switch gears, motor controls, electrical panels, CP cabinets, lighting, and power supplies
4. Testing electrical systems or continuity of circuits in electrical wiring, equipment, or fixtures, using testing devices, such as ohmmeters, voltmeters and meggers to ensure compatibility and safety of system
5. Ability to follow electrical code manuals to install and repair electrical systems
6. Understand schematic diagrams, blueprints and other specifications required by customer requirements
7. Experience working with hand tools, power tool and electronic test equipment
8. Strong working knowledge of job site safety as well as ability to complete a company specific safety orientation
9. Have a basic understanding of PLC installation
10. Ability to operate tugger, bender, threader, multi-meter, trencher, wacker, and various other trade specific equipment
